ARCHIE WARING

Archie Waring '29 served Walsh for 43 years (1926-69) in a variety of leadership roles, ranging from accountant, recruiter and registrar, to placement officer and instructor. Waring was the “heart and soul” of our school, leaving a deep imprint in its formative years. Waring’s legacy also includes serving as the Secretary of the Walsh College Alumni Association for many years.

In 1976, the Archie Waring Scholarship was established to recognize his many contributions to the College. In 1994, the Walsh Board of Trustees bestowed Waring with an honorary Doctorate of Laws degree. In 2008, Walsh named its new legacy society in honor of Archie Waring.
